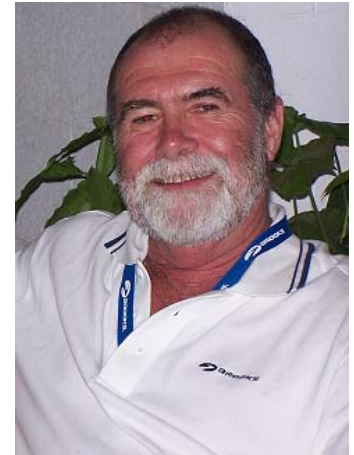
Jamie Bishop - "Unpredicta-Bull"
